<u>Annual Migrants Collection</u>: The Council for Migrants, Refugees and Justice and Peace of the Irish Episcopal Conference is inviting each diocese to take up a collection in 2025 in support of migrant people, whether they are coming to Ireland or indeed those Irish who have left these shores and are still very much part of our church and communities around the world. Funds raised through this collection will be used to support the work of the Council and other projects that provide pastoral outreach to marginalised and vulnerable communities within Ireland and among Irish people abroad.
