



# **Interesting Facts????**

Cranavane Holy Well outside of Kildavin was the site of annual patron day. The day of prayer was banned by local clergy when it also became a venue for faction fights. In one such fight the feud spilled over into the village of Kildavin.

Such was the ferocity of the fight that a stone thrown having missed its target hit the gate of Saint Pauls Church bending a metal bar on it. The gate when replaced was taken to the home of a member of St. Pauls Congregation as reminder of the battle. It remained there up to recently.

Another man was hit in the face at one of the faction fights with a stone in the toe of a stocking. He was so disfigured by the blow he became known locally ever after as "Crooked Face
