Burrenbeo

Landowners across the county (farmers and non-farmers, businesses, sporting organisations, schools and community groups) can now apply for support to create wildlife ponds, mini-woodlands, wildlife hedges, mini-orchards and 'plans for nature' on their land. Applications open until 20th March 2025 at <https://burrenbeo.com/thc/> We're offering micro-financing, materials, advice and encouragement to any Carlow landowner who wants to create space for nature on their property. Inspired by the term 'The Hare's Corner' - an old farming expression for an awkward section of a field, which wasn't intensively farmed and so was 'left to nature' (often referred to as Gearróg in parts of Carlow) - the aim of this project is to help create habitats that have proven benefits for biodiversity, for climate-action, and for the wellbeing of participants. We're aiming for 140 participants, and in a county the size of Carlow, that should make a significant impact to biodiversity

Interesting Facts : Planning for your Pension: The state contributory old age pension is paid to citizens who satisfy the qualifying criteria in respect of PRSI contributions when they reach the age of 66. At the moment it is possible to defer your pension until later and thereby get an increased amount. Any person in receipt of a contributory old age pension will get an additional payment for a dependant adult, the most common qualifying dependant adult is the pensioner's spouse. However, if the qualifying adult has paid PRSI in his or her own right and satisfies the contribution criteria he or she will be entitled to pension in their own right. Where each spouse receives a pension independently the total will usually be greater than that of one spouse receiving a pension with a dependant adult. It is prudent therefore in the case of family businesses run by both spouses, that declarations to Revenue reflect the fact that both parties are partners in the business and pay PRSI separately. You must have made PRSI contributions for at least 10 years before you apply for your pension.
