### Interesting Facts.

Anyone who drives over or past the bridge outside Kildavin on their way two or from Clonegal on the Wexford side of the river will notice a stone monument with the opening inscription Gate Of Tears (Geata Na nDeor). The monument marks the place where before the bridge and this road existed the river Derry was crossed by means of a ford located at the end of a lane that came over Drumderry Hill. Here emigrants from Clonegal parish had their last view of their native valley and the Wicklow Hills, here too they made their final goodbye to their relatives.
