Interesting Facts !!!!

Just outside Clonegal at the junction of the Carnew/Shillelagh Road and the Abbeydown Road, there is a triangular shaped field known as the Abbey Meadow. It is believed to have been the site of an ancient abbey from which the townland in which it is situated takes its name; Abbeydown. On the Carnew roadside of this field is a large rock with a very distinctive footprint in it. Locals have believed for centuries that this footprint was left by St Brigid during a visit to the Abbey
