Mysticism in an Age of Calamity: Meister Eckhart, John Tauler and Henry Suso

This summer, in the course of a two week online summer school, Donagh O'Shea OP has picked out passages where the meaning of the great mystics seems to come straight from their hearts, and perhaps straight from the heart of God. Each session will concentrate on three or four of these passages. The texts, one by one, each matched with a picture, will appear on your screen, so that you can go back to them at any time. There will be a spoken commentary in the background, drawing out the meaning of each passage, relating it to our own spiritual experience today. By absorbing these passages in a contemplative way, we may find in "the Winter of despair" (to use Dickens's words), "the Spring of hope."
