Congratulations and welcome to Archdeacon Adrian Wilkinson who has been elected new bishop of Cashel, Ferns and Ossory. The Venerable Adrian Wilkinson was born in 1968

and ordained in 1994. Archdeacon Wilkinson is married to Jacqui, who is lecturer in teacher education at the Church of Ireland Centre at Dublin City University, and they have three grown-up children – two sons and a daughter. He graduated in geography and sociology from Trinity College Dublin before training for ordination. He has been Archdeacon of Cork, Cloyne and Ross since 2014.
