Interesting Facts !!!!

Staff captain Charles Byrne Barragh was the last Carlow native to die in the Irish Civil War. Charles aged 22 died on the 27th of April 1923 in a shooting accident near Ballymurphy and is interred in Kildavin Cemetery: Charles is remembered in the recently published book "Lives Cut Short" by Christopher Power. The jhybook records the casualties of the 1916-1923 period associated with Carlow.
