# <u>Kildavin Clonegal GAA Club plans to re-open our Gym</u> <u>Facility on Monday, November 01<sup>st</sup> 2021, (subject to compliance with Government & GAA rules in place on this date).</u>

Anyone wishing to join to use the Gym Facility needs to Register with us for the first time or Re-Register with us if you have been a previous member.

Anyone who had pre-paid for Gym Membership before we were forced to close in March 2020 (due to the imposition of restrictions to deal with the Covid-19 Pandemic) can return their existing Gym Card and outline their claim for a refund from the Club. Their claim will be assessed and any refunds due will be reimbursed.

## <u>Details regarding Registration for the first time or Re-Registration as</u> follows:-

- Prospective members need to come to pre-defined registration nights (dates below) and bring the following items:-
  - A passport size photograph (one for each proposed member)
  - A colour copy of Photo ID with proof of age, ideally a Passport or a Drivers Licence
  - A paper copy of proposed member's EU Covid Certificate
  - A total of €15 in cash or cheque €5 for Club Social Membership for the year 2021 plus €10 as deposit for your Gym Card. (Club Social Membership for the full year of 2022 will be €20).
- The Gym & Social Membership Application Requirements & Payment Details Form must be completed
- Different Payment Options are available for Gym Use, but payments will only be accepted by Standing Order from November 01<sup>st</sup> 2021.

- Standing Order Payments are to be made on the 01<sup>st</sup> of each month, in advance.
- Membership will commence on the first of the month selected.
- Gym Induction must be completed and signed off on before Gym usage can commence. Pre-defined dates / times when Induction courses are being run will be outlined to prospective members at Registration.
- Only those who have reached 18 years of age are permitted to join the Gym and permitted to use it unaccompanied.
- Those who have reached 16 years of age are only permitted to use the Gym as part of a Supervised training session with their club / group supervisor present.
- Accepted Members must at all times fully comply with the Rules of our Gym Facility, which are subject to change from time to time.

Tuesday October 26<sup>th</sup> from 7:30pm to 8:30pm & Thursday October 28<sup>th</sup> from 7:30pm to 8:30pm .
