

Interesting Facts:!!!! A citizen of Clonegal committed to record in the middle of 20th Century, his knowledge of local customs. He wrote "In the old times people of this locality got up at sunrise on the first day of May. Then they would scratch or cut each of their cattle, and they would get a drop of blood out of each, and mix it with milk, and taste it. Men and women also bled themselves a little, and their blood was sprinkled on the ground." The purpose of these rituals was not recorded.
