The Retreat Giver is Seán Goan is a retired teacher and biblical scholar who studied Scripture in Rome, Jerusalem and in the University of Chicago. He has taught in the Milltown Institute, The Marino Institute of Education, The Priory Institute and the Dominican Lumen Centre in Sion Hill. He is also a founder member of the Tarsus Scripture School which was established in 2020 and which offers online courses on Scripture. He has worked widely in Adult Faith Development Programmes in parishes and dioceses around Ireland.

The course consists of four recorded presentations that will become available over the six Sundays of Lent ending on Palm Sunday, so on the first Sunday there will be access to one recording and on the second Sunday access to two recordings and so on. Participants can watch the films whenever suits them, and revisit films they have already viewed.

Patrick Nowlan of Abbeydown provided the following story to the children of Clonegal school in the 1930s "In the "Abbey Meadow" of Abbeydown there was supposed to be hidden a valuable treasure, consisting of Sacred vessels & gold. The only way to secure The Treasure was to dig, between the hours of midnight & Cock-Crow in the morning. Complete silence during the whole operation was essential to success. Several attempts were made but all were rendered fruitless by the fact that one or other of the workers broke the silence."
