





Interesting Facts:!!!! We have just begun the Lenten period, which in Christian Tradition is a time of preparation for Easter. In the past Roman Catholics were required to fast and abstain from meat on designated days during the period. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday were always termed black fast days and are the only remaining Lenten fast days. Each Diocese designated their fast days and the fast had to be observed within the boundaries of the diocese. It was noted that many including members of the clergy travelled to neighbouring diocese to avoid the fast in their own.
