Interesting Facts:!!!!

Sir Ernest Henry Shackleton (15 February 1874 – 5 January 1922) was an Anglo-Irish Antarctic explorer who led three British expeditions to the Antarctic and was one of the principal figures of the period known as the Heroic Age of Antarctic Exploration. He was born in Kilkea outside of Athy. The town of Athy is home to the Shackleton Museum. A Member of the Shackleton family a relative of the explorer lived and farmed in Coolroe just outside Clonegal. The Coolroe Shackleton was one of the casualties in this area of the very bloody 1798 rebellion.
