Interesting Facts:!!!! This weekend we celebrate our National Patron St, Patrick. There is much folklore surrounding his life in Ireland. He is believed to have entered the country in Wexford where he was made unwelcome and he and some of his monks were stoned. They moved north to Wicklow where it is believed that one of the monks who had his front teeth knocked out stayed and founded a monastery Cill Mhantáin which translates as church of the toothless one which remains the Irish name for Wicklow. His journey through Carlow was less eventful and in Rathvilly he is believed to have converted and baptised the Kinsella clan who at the time held the throne of Leinster
