

Interesting Facts!!!! 100 years ago in 1923 and almost immediately after the foundation of the state the first Nobel Prize to come to a citizen of the New Irish state was awarded to W. B Yeats for Literature. Yeats an Irish Protestant was considered one of the greatest poets of the 20th Century. His writings include a poem about the 1916 rising in which he famously wrote "All is changed changed utterly, A terrible beauty is born. His love affair with Maud Gonne the Irish Revolutionary who married one of the executed 1916 leaders, coloured his view of Irish politics and both his passion for Maud Gonne and his interest in politics is reflected in much of his writings.
