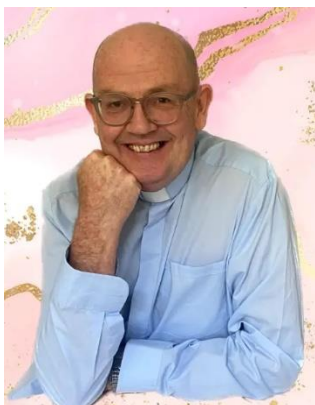

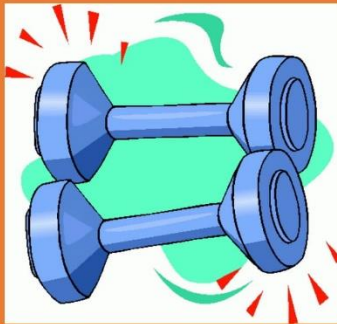

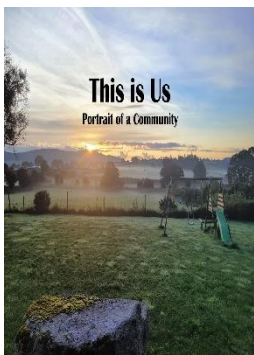
performance consultant Bernard Jackman on an advisory basis. His most recent role was as Westmeath minor hurling team manager.

Coolmelagh, in Irish Coill na Meala translated as Honey Wood is situated outside Clonegal and on the border with Tomacork Parish, the next Townland being Ballingate. A legend attaches to Coolmelagh wood currently favoured by walkers that the Dead Hunt could be seen there. The Dead Hunt was a ghostly procession of horses and huntsmen not of this world
