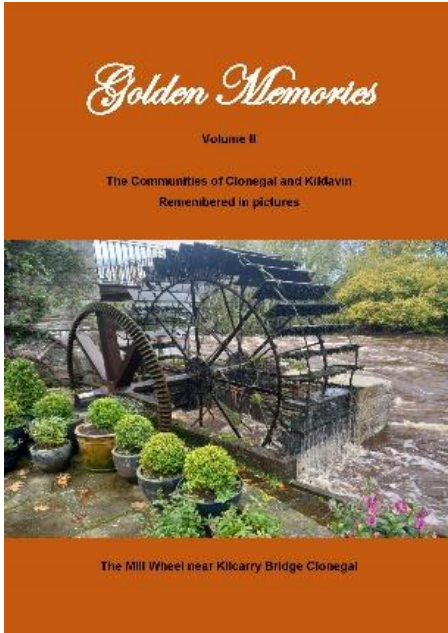

Interesting Facts:

Cromwell's invasion of Ireland in the 1650s was almost halted in Clonegal. Clonogan castle which protected the area appeared impregnable. However, an old woman tortured by Cromwell's troops revealed the weak side of the castle was the other side from Clonegal and Cromwell moved his canons around the structure and so it fell
